Physical Description 1

Largely intact, symmetrical facade with beaded weatherboards, hipped roof clad in corrugated metal sheeting (appears to have originally been slate on 1926 aerial), bi-chrome brick chimneys (west truncated), timber valance, brackets & panels to eaves. Concave verandah with turned timber posts, timber frieze & now with concrete deck. Timber sash windows with margin panes, Federation period panelled timber door with leadlight to upper part & original pilaster architraves & highlight with margin panes.
