Physical Description 1

Largely intact, weatherboard, hipped roof and gable roof clad in corrugated metal sheeting, brick chimneys (2 diff. types - 1 with terracotta pot, the other now partly rendered), decorative battens to gable end, some timber brackets remain to eaves (had been paired above verandah). Projecting bay to front with hood. Convex verandah with decorative detailing removed, renewed post, concrete deck. Paired timber sash windows, original architraves to door.
