Largely intact, asymmetrical, weatherboard, hipped roof now clad in tile shaped sheeting, exposed rafter ends, red brick chimneys, battened sheeting to gable end. Hipped verandah with timber frieze & deck, paired timber sash windows, altered windows to side, sidelight to door. Probably initially a pair with no. 13.
