Archaeological Significance Evidence may exist of early industrial activity associated with shipping and noxious trades. The recently removed iron tanks indicate further buried plant including pipes. It is likely that pumps, sumps and additional tanks remain. In addition, machinery mounts, discard dumps, and footings of demoslished buildings are likely to remain intact.

Historical Significance The former Nugget Polish Factory is associated with the late 19th century maritime industry, and 20th century manufacturing. The factory was originally built to provide laundry servicesfor ships docking at Williamstown. The building was used as teh Nuggest Polish Company Limited's manufacturing base from 1908 to 1974, and represents an influx of industry into Williamstown in the early 20th century. The word 'Nugget' become popularly associated with shoe polish in Australia. The factory later manufactured other well-known household products owned by the Reckitt & Colman group.
