Although this window was originally part of a church, it is now part of a residential redevelopment of the former church it was retained and became the feature of the stairwell, open to the mezzaine floor above. The image of *Sir Galahad* gained popularity as a subject for soldier memorial, usually, as here, taken from the GF Watts painting of *Sir Galahad* (1862).
