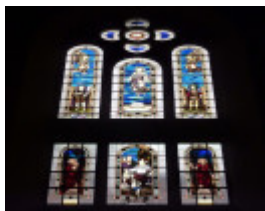

Memorial Window Description & History

The Methodist church at Ivanhoe was built in 1925 and was one of the larger auditorium-style suburban churches. In August 1925, the *Argus* reported that the church had received subscriptions amounting to nearly £100 for the window, which was expected to cost around £180. The large west window was one of several commissioned from EL.Yencken & Co. and designed by William 'Jock' Frater. The *Ascension* shows similarities with the same subject, also designed by Frater, for the Methodist church at Kyabram, and the figure of *Jonathan* was probably adapted from his earlier cartoons made for Anglican churches, St. Stephen's Wynyard (Tas.), Christ Church, Birregurra (Vic.) and Holy Trinity Maldon (Vic.).
