## **Memorial Window Description & Emp; History**

In August 1948, Dr. RE Fraser placed the order for a window measuring approximately 63 x 20 inches with Brooks, Robinson & Co. It was to depict the *Crown of Life* with the Presyterian symbol, the Burning Bush and motto at the head of the window. It is thought that the window was relocated to the new Uniting Church at Lucknow when St. Andrew's Presbyterian closed.
