

# **Memorial Window Description & Emp; History**

The window was one of a pair in the church that used a similar design of amber diamond quarries surrounded by a green border and a fine inner border of ruby glass. Both windows were ordered from Brooks, Robinson & Co.by F.J. Petschack in 1951 and each lancet measured 71 1/2 x 18 inches. The Cross & Crown symbolised death and the Resurrection of Christ and victory over death.
