STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

299 Moorabool Street has architectural significance at a local level. It is a representative example of a brick Bungalow, a common housing type in Geelong early this century. The residence retains characteristic form, siting, and a large gable roof with attic storey, typical of Bungalow housing, as well as some Federation Bungalow details.

DESCRIPTION

299 Moorabool Street is a double storey brick residence that is difficult to view from the street. The roof features an attic storey with a large side gable and a tall brick chimney with a pair of terracotta pots. The asymmetrical facade appears to feature typical Federation Bungalow details including timber wall shingles on the entrance portico and main gable, eaves with exposed rafters, and a bay window. The entrance portico has brick piers and a flat roof. The existing fence detracts from the Bungalow style of the house. Further inspection is required.
