History

Place History for the McEwan & Houston Ironmonger Site: The ironmonger is noted in the 1853 ratebooks a brick shop with four rooms, with a shed added the next year.

Place History for Former Stag and Hounds Hotel : The hotel was established in 1846 (W Lamont). It is noted on a plan (Taylor, 1854) as 'Stag Hounds'. It was also known as the Woolpack and the Bradford.
