History

The 1855 Mechanics Institute was originally a small structure. The sitewas expanded to include a hall; lecture room was located upstairs(50x30feet); reading room (46x20 feet); library (30x20 feet); 3 classrooms (2were located upstairs); secretary's office; and private apartments. Thefront of the institute faced Ryrie Street. The total cost of the expansion was £56,000 and was completed in March,1868 (B.W. Wheatland was themanager and secretary). A fire in June 0f 1926 destroyed the hall and stage, causing approximately £20,000. A new hall was built, known as the Plaza Theatre. Much of the plaza was destroyed in the 1970s to be redeveloped as the Geelong Performing Arts Centre.
