Largely intact, symmetrical bungalow with attic level, red brick, transverse gable roof clad in slate (with terracotta capping), brick chimneys with soldier course. Large gable dormer with shingled skirt & timber vent and battened sheeting to gable end. Smaller skillion dormers to either side.

Verandah to front with flat roof, timber brackets, brick piers (with clinker brick soldier course) supporting battered rendered columns.

Box framed timber sash windows to facade, timber sash windows to dormers, central double doors (timber framed, multi-paned).
