Physical Description 1

Projecting bay of original asymmetrical form has been extended forward (indicated by original sections of scalloped fascia) with the extant facade, porch & fence added, probably during the 1920s. Weatherboard, hipped & gable roof clad in corrugated metal sheeting, shingles & vertical timber screen to gable end. Porch with low rendered wall (now partly enclosed) & timber deck, timber windows with diamond quarrels to upper sash (boxed frame to porch), 4 panelled timber door with highlight & sidelights. Original rendered chimneys with terracotta pots. Scalloped fence - concrete with brick piers, hooped wire & wire gate.
