Largely intact, distinctive bungalow, red brick (lower part) and roughcast render (upper part), gable roof clad in terracotta tiles with terracotta finials, tall tapered rendered chimney, exposed rafter ends, decorative timber brackets to gable ends. Corner porch with low brick wall & tapered roughcast piers, pagoda-like brackets, timber casement windows with leadlight (hood to bay window), arched picture window to porch. Early clinker brick fence with open grille.
