Mostly intact, symmetrical facade, weatherboard, hipped roof clad in corrugated metal sheeting, rendered chimneys, decorative cornice to eaves. Verandah with convex roof (being replaced), concrete deck, cast iron frieze & original columns recently removed (now turned timber posts), timber sash windows with brackets, 4 panelled timber door with highlight & sidelights.
