Largely intact with Federation period addition to front. Weatherboard (beaded to facade of Victorian part), hipped roof clad in corrugated metal sheeting, brick chimneys (now painted) with terracotta pots, scalloped timber moulding to eaves of original part, timber brackets to eaves of addition. Concave verandah with timber framed cast iron frieze, turned timber posts & timber deck. Timber sash windows (hood to projecting part), panelled timber door with highlight.
