See *National Trust Study of Victoria's Concrete Road Bridges* (2008, 2010). This bridge is listed in 'Table 13: Other locally significant concrete bridges in Victoria identified in the Concrete Bridges Study' on p.114. It is described as a three-span bridge constructed of reinforced concrete 'T' beams with integral solid flat deck slab. Each span is just over 10.33m and the total length is 31m. It was constructed in 1930 and compares with the 1939 bridge over the Coalition Creek on the Strzelecki Highway, north of Leongatha. The bridge is situated on the Mardan Road, just to the east of the Lawson's Road intersection in Koorooman.
