Largely intact Queen Anne style villa, with addition to western end and later flat roofed porches. Original part is bi-chrome brick (red with cream banding and lintels), hipped & gable roof clad in slate, red brick chimneys, gable ends with roughcast render & decorative timberwork, timber sash windows to segmental arched openings (some with leadlight), painted sills. Additions with stretcher bond brickwork.
