Largely intact bungalow, weatherboard, gable roof clad in terracotta tiles, exposed rafter ends, roughcast and decorative timber to gable end. Brick & rendered wall & piers with decorative timber posts to porch, eastern side of porch infilled. Original timber bay with leadlight highlights, timber brackets & later aluminium window, large glazed timber door introduced to front, timber & wire fence.
