Physical Description 1

Mostly intact symmetrical facade with bay windows (casement leadlight windows with shingles below) introduced during Interwar period. Bi-chrome brick, hipped roof clad in corrugate metal sheeting, red brick chimneys, timber brackets to eaves with string moulding beneath, bullnose return verandah with cast iron frieze, fluted columns with capitals & tiled deck, timber panelled door with highlight & sidelights.
