Intact bungalow with symmetrical facade, weatherboard, gable roof clad in terracotta tiles, brick chimney with rendered capping & terracotta pots, early/original dormer (enclosed sleep-out) with shingles, timber vent, battened sheeting & later window. Porch with clinker brick wall, rendered capping & paired timber posts, timber bay windows to verandah with diamond quarrels to upper sash, paired timber doors.
