Bungalow, partly altered, gable roof clad in terracotta tiles, rendered chimneys with tall terracotta pots, battened sheeting to gable ends (with shiplap boards to main gable). 1926 aerial indicates side walls were weatherboard (now clad in brick). Porch with low brick wall now enclosed, timber sash windows to front bay, side entry now with pointed arch. Early brick fence with metal gate.
