Physical Description 1

Mostly intact, with later faux brick cladding. Early window hoods to side removed. Part of group of Federation houses. Hipped & gable roof clad in corrugated metal sheeting, brick chimneys (now painted). Bullnose verandah with cast iron frieze, turned timber posts & now with concrete deck. Tripartite timber sash windows (with early skillion hood to projecting part), original leadlight highlight & sidelight to entry.
