Mostly intact, weatherboard (previously beaded - 1991 study) hipped roof clad in corrugated metal sheeting, rendered chimneys with projecting capping, paired timber brackets & panels to eaves. Bullnose verandah with cast iron frieze, fluted columns with capitals & timber deck (verandah appears to have been rebuilt - earlier verandah had central projecting gable - refer to 1926 aerial). Tripartite timber sash windows, panelled timber door with leadlight to upper part & leadlight highlight & sidelights.
