The site was occupied only for less than 20 years. It has poor intactness, condition, and integrity, but may contain isolated artefacts.

The site is only significant at the local level.

Interpretation of Site

Evidence of the school site are subtle, consisting of two slightly raised building platforms – one $6m \times 5m$, the other $5m \times 3.5m$ – associated with a few fragments of red brick. The two questions to consider in respect to this hotel site are: (1) Does the site address the Heritage Act definition of an archaeological site? This point is clear as the site is more than 75 years old. (2) Does the site have more than a low level of archaeological value? Because of the site's known history, the school site may retain some archaeological values in the form of isolated artefacts.
