What is significant?

An individual Bunya Pine growing in the heritage listed Werribee Park.

How is it significant?

This tree is significant for scientific, landscape and historic reasons at the Regional level.

Why is it significant?

This Bunya Pine is scientifically significant for its large size in the western region, particularly the height and canopy spread. It is significant for its contribution to the landscape and is historically significant for being an original Chirnside planting from the 1870's at Werribee Park.
