Statement of Cultural Significance

Edina Cottage incorporates part of the bay steamer Edina. The north west elevation is a portion of the cabin from the vessel and is in good condition.

Edina Cottage is of historic value to the community of the Bellarine Peninsula.

Edina Cottage incorporates a portion of one of the most significant maritime vessels to ply its trade as a passenger and cargo carrier between Geelong, Portarlington and Melbourne. The Edina was an integral part of the Bellarine Peninsula's maritime history. Captain Forbes who had captained the ship for many years, salvaged part of it as a cabin at his Indented Head home. After his death it was incorporated into this house at St Leonards.

It is of LOCAL cultural significance.
