STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The SS Orungal anchor in the Barwon Heads Park at 7-71 Ewing Blyth Drive is **historically** and **scientifically** significant at a **LOCAL** level. It is associated with and contributes to an understanding of the history the wreck of the SS Orungal vessel, a mid twentieth century maritime disaster near Barwon Heads.

Overall, the SS Orungal anchor in the Barwon Heads Park at 771 Ewing Blyth Drive is of **LOCAL** significance.
