Physical Description 1

VISUAL DESCRIPTION/: This simple building has walls of adobe with a mud scrim over, on an ashlar bluestone base. It has a single skillion roof raking back, with (recent) timber shingles above ceiling level. There are standard timber windows with a three-sash central bay set forward, and a brick capped adobe letter box.
