Alluvial gold extraction site - includes shafts, water races, mullock heaps and evidence of sluicing. The area experienced an early gold rush 1859-1863 and activity increased again in the 1930s. These workings represent the typical activities associated with alluvial gold extraction and have at least a local significance.

Interpretation of Site Alluvial goldmining area associated with 1859 - 1863 goldrush with later workings particularly dating from the 1930s.
