

The house at no. 7 Athol Street Moonee Ponds was in existence in 1886. It is representative of other substantial villas erected in its vicinity and together with them demonstrates the impact of the railway on settlement and the status of the area as a residential location during the late Victorian period (Criterion A).

A polychrome Italianate villa with symmetrical facade having a central entry flanked by window bays and having a bellcast verandah. The verandah floor has bluestone margins and later cement infill whilst the sills and plinth are of dressed bluestone.
