What is significant?

The shop with upper level residence at 57 Puckle Street, Moonee Ponds built in 1899 for Richard Philpot.

Non original alterations and additions are not significant.

How is it significant?

The shop with upper level residence at 57 Puckle Street, Moonee Ponds is historically significant to the City of

Moonee Valley.

Why is it significant?

It is historically significant as a representative example of a shop and residence of its period, its cultural value having been diminished by the alterations sustained. (Criterion A)

Physical Description 1

A two storeyed shop and dwelling, the original shop front having been replaced and the upper level stuccoed with fluted pilasters lacking capitals. and a plain cornice with surmounting plain pediment. There is a single window with side lights. The condition is sound and external integrity is medium to low - the stucco work beneath the frieze being possibly of a later date.
