A Queen Anne styled, red brick and rough cast stuccoed villa, with adverse gabled wings, a communicating verandah, and a corner tower with flared spire. Of particular note are the fretted onion motifs in the expressed chimney shaft within the Dutch gable of the roof.

An original double palisade, capped picket fence with shepherds- crook posts, is at the frontage
