Greendale is one of a number of houses in the street which date from this period. Unlike many of these it is in a conservative late Victorian style. The timber house is asymmetrical with a block front facade. The concave verandah has a cast iron frieze and is supported on turned timber posts. The corrugated iron hipped roof has bracketed eaves.
