Interpretation of Site	In 1942 a degaussing range was proposed for the entry channel to Hobson's Bay. The facility consisted of a series of 18 copper tubes driven into the sea floor, a large dolphin with instrument shed and accommodation and a small dolphin with electric plant, located on the eastern side of the channel. A minesweeping range was located between a transit market on the west and a marking buoy on the east. A telephone cable ran from the facility to Point Ormo.
