Interpretation of Site

Ramp is located 1.5m north of Dunson Drive, which presumably was a track and used when the ramp was in operation. Ramp would have been used to load materials brought ashore near this point onto bullock drays. Historic maps indicate that a jetty was located on the coast north of the ramp. The ramp has been made using recycled timbers -the large horizontals are far thicker than required for the purpose of the ramp (32x32cm) and have slots cut into them and bolts that serve no function. The cut ends of the timber suggest that they were sawn by hand - probably with a cross cut saw.
