Budgeree is significant to the Cardinia Shire for its long association with the Greaves family who were prominent in the Shire and beyond. It is also unusual as a brick 19th century house built on a selection in a district where timber was more common. The Greaves were known for their brick villas (see Warook Homestead) which is a further physical association with the family.

The former post office building has local historical interest as a former public building known by many in the community.

Physical Description 1

This double-fronted face brick farm house is in an austere Italianate style, with a (new) return verandah and an hipped corrugated iron clad roof. At the rear is a gabled structure which is reputedly the former Yannathan bank & post office. It is a weatherboard gabled building sited next to a tennis court. The former site of this structure is marked by a stone pine some distance from the property, north-east corner Caldermeade Road and Swamp Road.

The house is set back from the road in open pasture. Planting includes remnant hawthorn hedges (better examples opposite); and a mature stone pine at the corner of Swamp and South Yannathan Roads (in property?).
