Interpretation of Site	At some point there was probably a farm house associated with this well (although no house remains were located). The well's construction date is likely to be late 19th century. Further background research or archaeological excavation is required to properly date this site.
Archaeological Significance	The integrity of the well is excellent and its internal deposits would be well stratified. There is no known documentary evidence, further research would be useful. Wells such as this are not rare in Victoria. For this reason the site holds medium archaeological significance.
Historical Significance	Until further research is conducted regarding the history of the site the historical significance is low.
