*What is significant?*

The Wellsford Guard House [Munitions Store], at 1-3 Rifle Range Road, Wellsford is significant.

*How is it significant?*

The Wellsford Guard House [Munitions Store] is of local historical and aesthetic significance to the City of Greater Bendigo.

*Why is it significant?*

The Wellsford Guard House is of historical significance for its association with land reserved for military purposes and training at the rifle range. *Criterion A*

It is of aesthetic significance as a rare building type, and one that is associated with Defence Department sites only. *Criterion B*
