Last updated on -

"Nettalie" is understood to have been built prior to 1871 and has local importance as an early residence in Caulfield North demonstrating the settlement of the area by Melbourne's gentry and having architectural distinction for its fretted barges in the Carpenters' Gothic manner. This importance is enhanced by the villa's intact state and the mature plantings in the front garden.

Physical Description 1

A single storeyed symmetrical stuccoed villa with recessed hip roofed central section with bell cast, cast iron verandah and flanking pavilions with bayed windows and distinguishing fretted barges. The roof pitch is shallow giving an appearance to the pavilions characteristic of the mid Victorian period. The interior spaces with stained glass screen to the hallway are intact.
