Though the adjacent houses vary in integrity, 243 Moreland Rd remains substantially intact. The terrace as a whole is of regional significance as one of the furthest north and most impressive examples of this type built in the northern suburbs of Melbourne in the late 19th century (Hubbard 1991).

Physical Description 1

Second terrace house in row of seven built in rendered brick with bluestone detailing. Built c. 1890, it is typical of the Boom period and this building type.
