What is significant?

The house at 61 Cumberland Road, Pascoe Vale South.

How is it significant?

The house at 61 Cumberland Road, Pascoe Vale South is of local historic significance and aesthetic significance to the City of Moreland.

Why is it significant?

Of historic significance, as the only house built as part of repeated efforts to develop this area of Pascoe Vale in the late nineteenth century. Also, for its associations with the failed development of Bolingbroke Village. (AHC Criterion A.4)

Of aesthetic significance, as a good example of a Boom style late nineteenth century Italianate villa, in an area where there are few examples of this type of building. (AHC Criterion E.1)

Physical Description 1

The house at 61 Cumberland Road is a single storey polychrome brick Italianate villa with an asymmetrical front facade and a hipped slate roof. The chimneys are unpainted render with decorative caps. The house features a projecting bay window to the front elevation, with segmental arched double hung sash windows to the sides of the bay and a round arched double hung sash to the front, which is slightly larger than the side windows. All other windows are double hung sashes. The front verandah has cast iron decorative lace and cast iron columns with a corrugated iron (painted red) roof. The four panel front door has side and highlights.
