What is significant?

The house at 54 Rennie Street, Coburg.

How is it significant?

The house at 54 Rennie Street, Coburg is of local aesthetic significance to the City of Moreland.

Why is it significant?

Of aesthetic significance, as a good example of a substantial Inter-war brick residence which retains its original brick garage, front fence and original landscaping elements. (AHC Criteria D.2 & E.1)

Physical Description 1

54 Rennie Street is a two storey free-standing clinker brick Inter-war residence with a glazed terracotta tiled hipped roof, with a gable over the projecting side front elevation. Features include: a combination of Old English and International Modern timber framed windows, a projecting front entrance, clinker brick chimney, single storey attached clinker brick garage with a painted timber door, a low front fence with contemporary vine and a number of mature trees.
