How is it significant?

Dunne's Buildings at 436-442 Sydney Road, Coburg is of local historic and aesthetic significance to the City of Moreland.

Why is it significant?

Of historic significance, for its associations with the Dunne family who had extensive land holdings in the area and were responsible for both settlement and development within Coburg and Pascoe Vale. (AHC Criterion H.1)

Of aesthetic significance as a good example of Victorian a Victorian shop row, which contributes to the historic character of Sydney Road. (AHC Criterion E.1)

The shops known as Dunne's Building at 436-442 Sydney Road, Coburg, is a group of four Victorian two storey shop fronts which are altered at street level but are reasonably intact to the upper storey. The shops fronts are identical, painted render bays, with a pair of elongated double hung sash windows in each. The windows are distinguised by stylised detailing including pediment. A parapet runs along the length of the building and is similarly separated into bays, with a central stylised dutch gable to each.
