The Edgar's Creek Reserve is of local significance for its historical associations with the Woiworung and farming, the original lifeblood of Coburg North. It is also Coburg's most important recreation reserve east of the Merri Creek, servicing Coburg's North and the Housing Commission of Victoria's Newlands Estate

Physical Description 1

The former Kirkwood Golf Links, now a driving range, are on the western bank of the Creek. Golf road forms the south western boundary and an SEC transmission line runs the length of the creek to the municipal boundary. The southern end is threatened by a proposed freeway. The landscaping is grass and natives, recently planted. The eastern bank includes playing fields and a basketball stadium.
