What is significant?

The Pines (former), comprising the house constructed c.1880 at 11Willett Avenue, Oak Park

How is it significant?

The Pines (former) at 11 Willett Avenue, Oak Park is of local historic significance to the City of Moreland.

Why is it significant?

Of historical significance as one of only two examples of late nineteenth century farmhouses in the Oak Park area.

It demonstrates an early phase of farming settlement and development of Oak Park, on part of land that was originally settled and farmed by John Pascoe Fawkner. (AHC Criterion A.4)

Physical Description 1

The house at 11 Willett Street, Oak Park is a very altered Victorian farmhouse. The house has been divided into two flats.

It is now one of only two nineteenth century houses in the Oak Park area. The other is the more substantial Oak Park house at 7 Oak Park Court (refer to separate citation in this Study)
