Typical of more elaborate timber homes of the 1880s, this Victorian timber villa with its ashlar block facade has corbelled brick chimneys (now painted) and generous facade openings, with ornate timber work. The convex verandah with lacework is new, reflecting characteristic features which were probably originally incorporated in the design.
