History

Heritage Inventory History of Site: The race track is associated with James Wilson and the St Albans Homestead, Whittington. Built in 1873, the circular track was 1 3/4 miles in circumference and 36 '6" wide, built up in places with shell and surfaced with tanbark. The track sloped inwards and was drained by pipes. Several buildings associated with the race track seem to have been removed or demolished.
