History

Heritage Inventory History of Site: The region around Geelong, including the Barrabool Hills was a major source of building stone - especially granite, sandstone and limestone from the 1840's. McCanns and nearby Holdsworth quarries, dating from this period, were two of a number that supplied Barrabool sandstone. McCanns quarry is still being used today (for further information refer to internal memo 26/6/98, included with the site record).
