Old school house which was built in 1885 adjacent to the Parish Church of St Peter, Eastern Hill, was designed by William Pitt with two doors giving separate entrance for boys and girls. The School House and adjacent Parsonage are similar in character and share some unusual roof gable details. The old school house now provides living quarters for clergy and their families. The addition to the rear is not included.
